## NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

### Rules Applying to Dog Shows

Effective January 1, 2010

#### CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1.

No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.

## **ATTENTION EXHIBITORS Dallas Market Hall Over 170,000 Square Feet of Space All on One Level!**

### **PREFERRED GROOMING SPACE:**

In order to provide better comfort & protection for you & your dogs, the Lone Star State Classic will offer preferred crating & grooming space. This will allow you to unload dogs at your leisure, when the building is fully air-conditioned. For exhibitors who do not show until Saturday, you can save on hotels bills & still be assured of having a space. Reservations close on a specific date so Please see the all-breed premium list for the reservation form.

**SITE AVAILABILITY:** There will be an availability to drive in to unload please see the all-breed premium list for the information and times

1. Exhibitors with & without grooming space reservations can drive in to unload on Wednesday at times specified in the allbreed premium list.
2. All engines & generators must be turned off during unloading & loading
3. The building will be locked at 11:00 pm and opened at 6:00 am all four days of the event for exhibitors.
4. Exhibitors are required to unload & remove their vehicles as quickly as possible. You can set up your equipment after your vehicle is removed.
5. All dogs & equipment must be removed immediately following BIS on Sunday, July 5, 2009.
6. The building is fully air conditioned except during hours of vehicle access. Please plan accordingly.

### **ACCESS & PARKING:**

1. All loading & unloading must be done through the Loading Doors in the North Hall. No crates, dollies, pens, or other equipment can be transported through other doors or entrances to the building. Valet parking will be available Friday, Saturday & Sunday.
2. Absolutely no cones allowed in parking areas.
3. We have space for a limited number of motor homes to park in the lot adjacent to the building. Use the Reserved Overnight RV Parking form in the all-breed premium list to mail in to reserve your space. You will be put on the list for your space if you make a reservation - if your name does not appear on the list, you will not be allowed to park in the lot. You must enclose a stamped, self addressed envelope for confirmation of your reservation. No reservation of parking space by cones or other means.
4. Absolutely no dumping of holding tanks on the grounds. Any unit suspected of a gray water or sewage leakage will be asked to leave the parking lot.
5. All vehicles must be removed from the facility immediately following Best in Show on Sunday, July 5, 2009.
6. During the show, all exhibitors will enter the property through the North Hall doors where the main grooming area is located. The Spectator entrance will be at the North Entrance to the Main Hall where the ticket booth is located.

### **EXHIBITOR ACCESS WEDNESDAY THROUGH SUNDAY:**

PROOF OF ENTRY WILL BE REQUIRED FOR FREE

BUILDING ACCESS WEDNESDAY THROUGH SUNDAY OF THE EVENT. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

Exhibitor pins will be distributed to all exhibitors for all days of the event FOR ACCESS TO THE BUILDING & TO THE SHOW FLOOR WHERE THE RINGS ARE LOCATED. Pins may be picked up at the Information & Catalog Table.

### **RESERVED GROOMING:**

- Reservations must be received no later than close of entries. Monies will not be refunded & reservations cannot be changed after closing. Confirmation of grooming space & a map will be sent if a stamped, selfaddressed envelope is enclosed.
- Check must accompany reservation form (no credit cards).
- *Do not include reservation form & check with entries.*
- Reservations are for 4 days, no partial reservations accepted.
- Reservations are limited & are on a firstcome, firstserve basis. When reserved space limit has been reached, additional reservations will be returned.
- Only 1 request for space per envelope will be accepted. All others will be returned.
- No fax, email, walkins or telephone reservations will be accepted.
- Access to electrical plugs is not exclusive & is not reserved.
- Reserved space will be strictly enforced.

### **CRATING & GROOMING SPACE:**

1. Crating & grooming space will be reserved, although space will be provided for exhibitors without reservations & for day crating.
2. Please stack hardsided crates. Soft sided crates will be allowed in the building, BUT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BE LEFT WITH A DOG IN THEM UNSUPERVISED OR OVERNIGHT. ANY VIOLATION IS SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINE. Softsided crates are not allowed to be stacked.
3. The Show Committee will mark all crating & grooming space. Only approved crating & grooming space may be used. ROPING OFF OR OTHERWISE RESERVING UNUSED CRATING & GROOMING SPACE IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.

4. The Show Committee reserves the right to require the stacking of crates, limiting the use of exercise pens & any other remedies it may deem necessary for space in nonreserved spaces on a case by case basis at their discretion.
5. The Show Committees reserve the right to remove exercise pens anywhere in or around the building. THERE WILL BE NO EXERCISE PENS ALLOWED IN NONRESERVED GROOMING. There will be space provided somewhere in the building for private exercise pens for those in nonreserved grooming with a limit of 2 ex-pens per setup. Expens must be labeled & kept clean. Sawdust must be used in the pens & changed daily. Sawdust will be provided for a fee by the Lone Star State Classic if you have forgotten to bring your own.
6. POSITVELY NO EXERCISING WILL BE PERMITTED OUTSIDE THE BUILDING EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED AREAS. Dogs are not allowed in the landscape area around Dallas Market Hall, or in the lawn or shrubs around the complex. Failure to observe the rules may result in an Event Hearing. Outdoor exercise pens will be provided.
7. No rugs or mats allowed in nonreserved grooming areas. NO PLASTIC ALLOWED ON FLOORS UNDER EXERCISE PENS. Please use sawdust in pens & change daily. NO ELECTRICAL CORDS ALLOWED IN THE AISLES. No sod allowed in the building.
8. Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning his setup each day. REMEMBER TO BRING A BROOM.
9. Public exercise pens will be provided & must be attended by owner or handler while in use.

#### **DAY CRATING:**

Space will be provided for exhibitors who want to "Show & Go".

Crates & grooming tables will be allowed. No exercise pens or drop pens in Day Crating. Everything must be removed immediately following Best in Show judging each day or the Show Committee will remove & discard same.

#### **SECURITY:**

24 hour security will be provided inside & outside the building.

All persons attending these dog shows hereby waive any claims for damages against the Lone Star Weimaraner Club, Trinity Valley Kennel Club, Inc., the Greater Collin Kennel Club, Inc., the Texas Kennel Club, Inc., the Superintendent or their members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

#### **BUILDING RULES**

1. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED TO BE BROUGHT INTO THE BUILDING. SMOKING AND/OR USING TOBACCO PRODUCTS ARE PROHIBITED IN ANY SPACE IN THE DALLAS MARKET HALL.
2. NO FOOD OR DRINKS MAY BE BROUGHT INTO THE BUILDING. ONLY FOOD PURCHASED FROM THE CONCESSIONAIRE CAN BE CONSUMED IN THE BUILDING.
3. PUPPIES UNDER THE AGE OF SIX MONTHS & UNENTERED DOGS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED FROM ENTRY INTO THE BUILDING.
4. Skates, skateboards, scooters & strollers are not allowed in the building (with the exception of ADA approved aids). Balloons of any type or helium tanks are not allowed.
5. No decoration of any type shall be attached to the ceiling, walls, floor, furnishings or fixtures. No artificial snow, glitter, confetti, rice or birdseed is allowed.
6. Responsibility for an exhibitor's child is the exhibitor's both for the child's welfare & any damages done by the child.

#### **EXTENSION CORD REQUIREMENTS**

The City of Dallas enforces the 1996 National Electrical Code to ensure the public is not exposed to electrical hazards. This Code has specific requirements for the type of extension cord, that may be used and how they are used.

If extension cords are used, Ground Fault Circuit Interrupt Protection (GFCI) is required. This cord is sold at most building or electrical supply stores. These cords are easily recognized as they have a test and a reset button on the cord. Most of these cords have the words "GFCI protected" printed on the cord.

All 120volt extension cords shall be three wire grounding type cords (recognized by the three-prong plug on the end of the cord). Frayed or damaged cords may not be used. Extension cords may not be placed through doorways or across aisles.

These requirements will help eliminate harmful or fatal electrical hazards to you and/or your animals. City staff, including Fire Inspectors will check the premises from time to time for your compliance.

Your cooperation is appreciated.

#### **NOTICE**

All rights to TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE or otherwise exploit these events are vested in the Clubs, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Clubs. All persons and animals on the Show grounds at any time while the Shows are in progress, do by attending these shows or participating therein, grant to the Clubs the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.

Prize money will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog.

All catalogs will be sold. None will be given away.

The Lone Star Weimaraner Club, Greater Collin Kennel Club, Inc., Texas Kennel Club, Inc. & Trinity Valley Kennel Club, Inc. are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at these shows.

**This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.**

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.**

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its **Show Secretary** will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The **Show Secretary** is not able to cash checks.

**RETURNED CHECKS/INVALID CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The **Show Secretary** will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check & credit/debit card. Subsequent returned checks & credit/debit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the **Show Secretary**.

The show giving Club, the **Show Secretary**, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

All entry monies received via PayPal will have a service charge of \$2 per dog and per entry added. If the credit/debit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge will be added.

**Facsimile Machine** entries for this show will be accepted up to closing time. Both sides of entry form must be submitted. If you pay the fees via PayPal be sure to include the fees of \$2/dog/per entry. If the credit/debit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge will be added. Fax number is 817 796 2604. This is for Facsimile Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible FAX entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Chapter 11, Section 4).

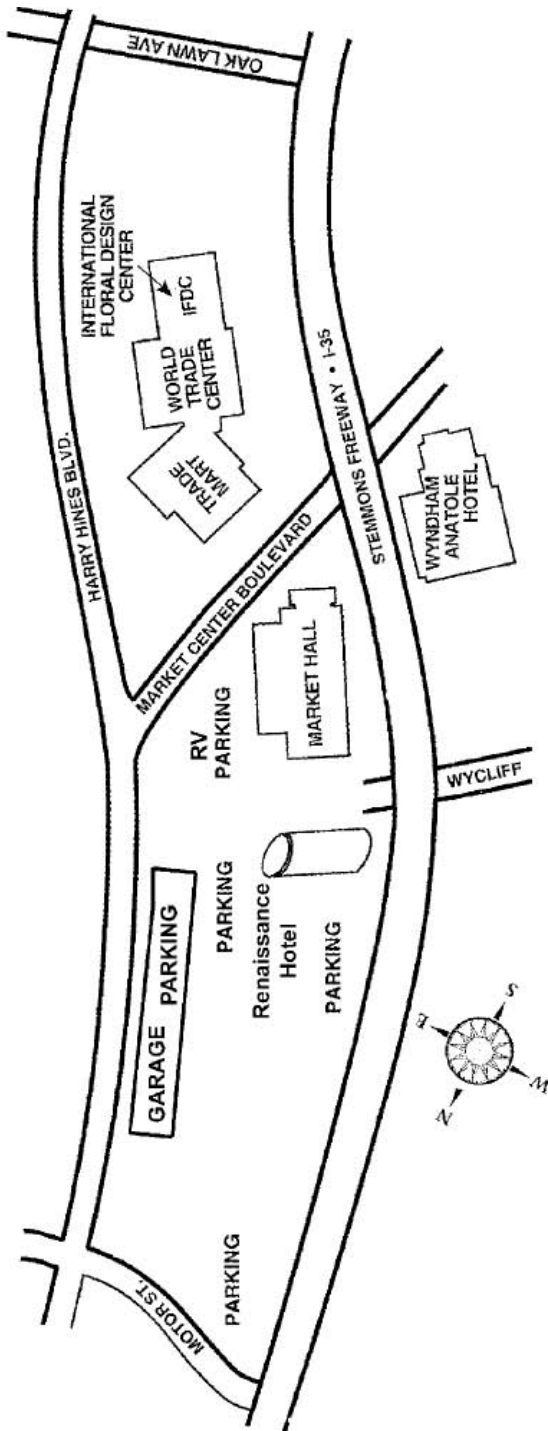

Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth),
2. 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
